This package contains 18 strips of reflective tape — enough to outfit one rail car.

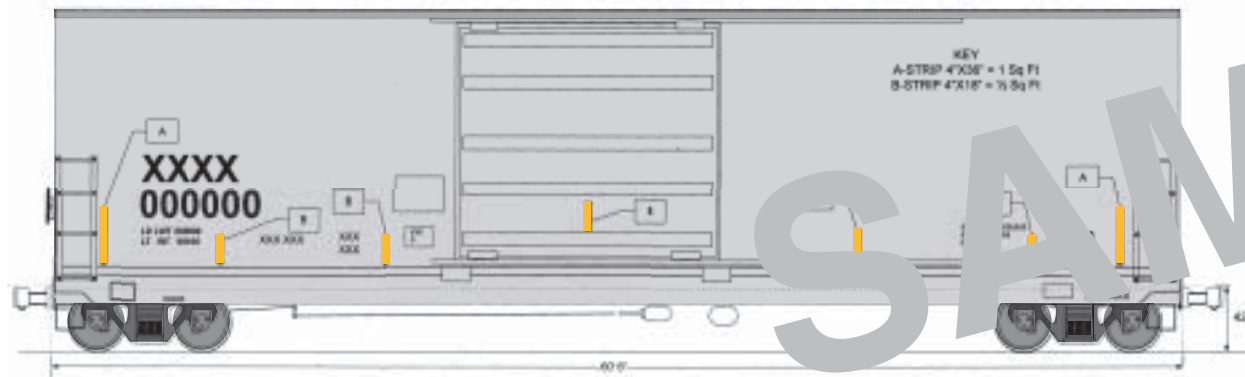

The Federal Railroad Administration (FRA) published a Final Rule on January 3, 2005: 49 CFR part 224, Reflectorization of Rail Freight Rolling Stock. The Final Rule summary reads as follows: FRA is issuing this final rule to mandate the reflectorization of freight rolling stock (freight cars and locomotives) to enhance the visibility of trains in order to reduce the number and severity of accidents at highway-rail grade crossings in which train visibility is a contributing factor. This rule establishes a schedule for the application of reflective material and prescribes standards for the construction, performance, application, inspection, and maintenance of the material.

The 18 strips of tape included in this package are marked "FRA-224" and meet or exceed 49 CFR part 224, Reflectorization of Rail Freight Rolling Stock certification.

Yellow is the recommended color of the Federal Railroad Administration. Additional sheeting may be required per 49 CFR 224.105 Sheeting Dimensions and Quantity if white sheeting is applied in lieu of yellow.

Refer to figures 1 – 5 (figures 2 – 5 are located on the back of this package) for typical application patterns. For alternative application patterns, refer to regulation 49 CFR part 224.106 Location of Retroreflective Sheeting.
