Overview	The driver of a commercial motor vehicle in interstate commerce must be at least 21 years old. A motor carrier may not require or permit a driver under 21 to operate in interstate commerce. The regulations do not specify a maximum age limit for drivers.
Exceptions	Several states allow a driver who is under 21 years old to operate a commercial motor vehicle in intrastate commerce. In many cases the driver may not transport a placardable amount of hazardous materials or more than a certain number of passengers. Consult individual state regulations for specific details.
